SPP specific workshops:


- International conference in Sept. 2020, ICHEM 2020

- 3 PhD per year going abroad for 4 months (1200 €) + flight ticket
 (1200 €) → max. 6.000 € per visit.
- PhD coming in from outside Germany (air fare by foreign host):
 5 selected people (4,800 €each)
- Invitations to 4 senior guest scientists max. 2.740 €per visitor
- Start-up funding for 2 young researchers (salary + student help + consumables)
- Gender equality measures
- Mercator fellow: An-Chou Yeh, NTHU, Taiwan
- Public related issues





- Results with respect to novelty of research area.
- Interaction of individual projects (within disciplines and interdisciplinary).
- International visibility, international networking.
- Scientific gain of knowledge.
- German wide distributed projects, synergy effects used?
- Support of young academics, gender issues.
- Push to new (joint) research activities?
- Transfer of knowledge (towards industry)?
